### Required Qualifications

1. **(n 1)** Applicants must hold one of the following qualification.
  - a. A bachelor's degree in psychology with a GPAX of at least 2.50 (on a four-point grading scale) or
  - b. Currently studying in last semester of a bachelor's degree in psychology with a GPAX at least 2.50.
- (n 2)** Applicants must hold one of the two following qualification
  - a. A bachelor's degree in any discipline with a GPAX of at least 2.50 or
  - b. currently studying in last semester of a Bachelor's Degree in any discipline with a GPAX at least 2.50.
  - c. In addition, all applicants in (n 2)
  - d. must have taken and passed at least 1 psychology course. This can be a college-level General Psychology or other comparable psychology courses, or psychology-related online or public training courses with certification of achievement (i.e., a satisfactory performance on an exam or other forms of evaluation must be achieved as a condition to pass the course).
2. English proficiency. Applicants must either a) submit an English proficiency test result with a score equivalent to or above one of the following criteria:
  - CU-TEP 67 or
  - TOEFL 525 or
  - IELTS 5.5
 Or b) graduated from overseas universities where English is used as the language of instruction and assessment. The university must also be recognized by Thailand's Office of the Civil Service Commission.
3. A thesis proposal in the field of Cognitive Psychology, outlining goals, relevant literature, hypothesis, and potential methods of the study. The proposal must be written in English and is no longer than 3,000 words.
4. A statement of purpose. The statement of purpose must be written in English and is no longer than 1,000 words, illustrating the applicants' motivation for studying in the program and their career plan after graduation.
5. Other qualifications according to the annual announcement of the Graduate School, Chulalongkorn University.
6. Any exemption from the required qualifications above must be approved by the M.S./Ph.D. in Psychological Science Program committee.
